Jesus is King.


Activity and Craft Supplies:

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Easter 1: Activities



Activity:

Pin the Tail on the Donkey: Purchase the game or draw a large donkey (without a tail). One at a time, blindfold the children and have them try to place a paper tail with tape on the donkey.

Simon Says: Play Simon Says with each child holding a green streamer. Periodically say "Hosanna to the King" and have the child wave the streamer.

Craft:


Palm Branch: Paint the Palm Branch Printable with watercolors. While the paint is still wet, sprinkle with salt. Allow the painting to dry and then brush off the salt. A pretty stained-glass look will be left! Cut out if time allows.

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Easter 1: Bible Time



Supplies:

- Bible
- Green Streamers cut 2 feet long

Flannelgraph:

- Water/Sky Board with Land, S4
- Jesus 3, 4
- Disciples 18, 20, 56
- People 88, 97A

- Donkey 154
- Palm Branches 186
- Coats 287, 288

In a few weeks, we are going to celebrate another holiday. Raise your hand if you know that holiday. Easter is the time that we celebrate how much Jesus loves us. We are going to take a break from _____ to learn about the events of Easter.

One day, <u>Jesus</u> and His <u>disciples</u> were walking toward Jerusalem. *Pat your legs*. Let's pretend to walk. As Jesus and His friends came closer to the town, Jesus sent two of the disciples ahead to get a donkey. Count Jesus' two friends. 1, 2. *Show on fingers*. Because the disciples loved Jesus, they obeyed what Jesus said to do. *Remove two disciples*.

Now, donkeys can be very stubborn and donkeys don't always want to move where you want them to, so let's imagine that the two disciples had to "pull" the donkey to Jesus. Pull that donkey. When the disciples finally got the <u>donkey</u> to Jesus, the Bible says that the disciples took off their coats, put the <u>coats</u> on the donkey (add one to board), and helped Jesus sit on the donkey. Remove standing Jesus and add Jesus sitting on donkey.

Jesus rode the donkey into town and the <u>people</u> looked at Him. The people spread their <u>coats</u> (add second to board) on the road and shouted in worship "Hosanna to the King." Hosanna means "save now." The people knew that Jesus would save them. Some waved <u>palm branches</u> in the air to worship Jesus. Others laid <u>palm branches</u> in the road to worship Jesus. The people were happy to see Jesus because of all the wonderful things Jesus had done. The people worshiped Jesus in whatever way they could.

I am going to give you a pretend palm branch (green streamer) to wave at Jesus just like the disciples and people did.

Sing "He is the King of King" and wave palm branches or green streamers. Traditional Song He is the King of Kings (wave branches)


He is the Lord of Lords
