

Christmas 1: Baby Jesus is Coming



Scripture: Luke 1:26-38, Matthew 1:18-24

Memory Verse: Matthew 1:21b

Why did God give us such a wonderful gift?

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Jesus is my gift.


Activity and Craft Supplies:

Christmas 1: Activities



Activity:

Building: Joseph was a carpenter or a builder. Give the children play construction tools and large blocks, and tell them to build like Joseph.

Dance Freeze: Play a kids' song from Cd's such as *Hide 'Em in Your Heart, Go Fish,* and *Seeds Family Worship*. Instruct the children to dance as the music plays. As soon as the music stops, each player must immediately freeze until the music begins again. This could be free dance or give the children a specific movement for each time. Discuss how God wants us to obey just as Mary and Joseph obeyed the angel.

Gift Relay Race: Line up the children in two lines, one on each side of the room, facing each other. Give the first child in Line 1 a medium-sized wrapped box. The child must carry the gift to the first person in Line 2 using only his elbows. Take turns carrying the gift. If time allows, have the children carry the gift in other ways (e.g. between knees, between two children watching back-to-back).

Mary Had a Baby Based on Traditional Song



Show present. Raise your hand and tell me what this is. Raise your hand and tell me what you think is in this present. Respond with "maybe." Raise your hand and tell me who you think the gift is for. Respond with "maybe."

This month is December and we know that there is a special holiday this month. Raise your hand and tell me what holiday it is. Christmas is in December. Now, raise your hand and tell me why we have Christmas. Of course we love the presents, Christmas trees, and yummy food, but there is more to Christmas than all of that. God made a promise a long, long time ago of a very special gift. Clear back in the Old Testament, God made a promise of this gift.

Show present. Put your finger on your knee if you think God was talking about a present like this. No. God's gift didn't come in a box. God's gift was a baby. A very special baby.

The Bible tells us that a young girl named <u>Mary</u> was to be married to a man named Joseph. An <u>angel</u> appeared to her and said, "Greetings! The Lord is with you." Pretend to be an angel and tell Mary "Greetings!"

Mary was very confused. Show me a confused face. The Angel said, "You are going to have a baby. The baby is the Son of God." Mary said, "This is impossible." The Angel said, "Nothing is impossible with God." Mary said, "I am the Lord's servant." Mary was saying that she would do whatever God wanted her to do.

This month we are going to be talking a lot about God's gift...a baby. Raise your hand if you know the name of the baby. Jesus! Jesus is God's gift to us.

Put on your thinking cap because I have a really hard question. *Put on pretend hat*. Raise your hand and tell me why God gave us Jesus, such a wonderful gift. God gave us the gift of Jesus because He loves us so much!

If you like to receive gifts, give me a thumbs up. We all like receiving gifts. But the gift that God gave us... Jesus...is the best gift of all!

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
